IJPC Associates are given a special password to allow them to download the IJPC Database 2007 in Access, Excel or other database programs.

The IJPC Database includes five columns of comments (255 characters in each column). The First Column, COMMENTS – OCCUPATION starts with the occupation of the principal journalist or journalists in the entry. “Reporter” and “Journalist” are the largest categories. A sub-category is an ethnic designation: “African-American.”






